NOTE:All the fees should be paid with the issued tellers on or before **Friday September 11, 2026**. Please all fees should be paid in the student's full name. Students will collect **the list of books** after submission of bank teller & collection of receipt. More so, the Bursary office is always open from 9,00am to 2.00pm on Tuesdays & Wednesday for change of receipts. Conversion of tellers to receipts on the day of resumption may no longer be obtainable. **NO PAYMENT VIA POS/ATM**

2.04: READING CULTURE: Encourage your ward on the need to always read hard , because there is no shortcut to success.

2.05: REMEDIAL CLASSES: There shall be EXTRA/REMIDAL CLASSES for students whose **ANNUALCUMMULATIVE AVERAGE** fall between 40% - 49.9% on Saturday August 8th, 2026 to Friday September 5th,2026 and are invited/shortlisted. **The fee is Fifty thousand naira only (₦50, 000)**, to be paid to the school "ACCESS BANK ACCOUNT". Those not invited/fail to attend shall either repeat their classes or advised to change school. The shortlisted for the Remedial Classes shall be duly communicated on their Convent results.

2.06: TEXTBOOKS: Textbook imbibes reading culture, compliment and harmonize the teacher effort for the attainment of desirable results. Regrettably, most students are deprived of this companion. So as we prepare for new academic session, the convent advises that parents/guardians should endeavour to equip their daughters with recommended textbooks for the new class. These textbooks are available in the school bookshop at affordable prices.

2.07 NATIONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (NIN): All prospective SS 1 – SS 3 students are expected to go for NIN registration and, submit evidence of the registration on the day of resumption. Parents are implored to be mindful of their daughter's particulars for the registration as all information shall also be used for their WAEC, NECO and JAMB registrations.

2.08: FIRST TERM CALENDAR FOR 2026/2027 ACADEMIC SESSION

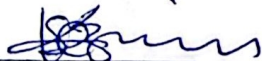
3.00: RESUMPTION DATE: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19th, 2026. Students are to return on or before 4pm with all necessary requirements - Receipts, outfit materials, Photocopies of your annual and termly results obtained from the Convent website, recommended textbooks as well as letter from their Priests, Subjects selection form. New students will come back on Saturday 26th September, 2026.
